BUDGET BETTER IN THREE STEPS

Here are three basic steps everyone should use to develop a successful budget.

- Determine monthly income. It is important to include all sources of income in this number. Be sure to use your net income, which is the amount of money you receive after taxes and other deductions.
- Identify high-priority bills. Examples of this include a mortgage or rent payment, basic utilities, auto payment, and insurance premiums. These payments are usually a fixed amount, and you are expected to pay them each month.
- Estimate other expenses. After you subtract the priority bills from your net income, you will ideally still have money left for other important expenses like groceries, gasoline, and credit cards. Try your best to estimate how much these expenses are, and track your spending habits to monitor the accuracy of your estimates.

SPRING SEASONAL SAVINGS GUIDE

We are here to share with you a few ways you can make some hidden savings each month.

April: Tax time is near! If you haven't done so already, start prepping. Round up your records (receipts, canceled checks, and a copy of your Social Security card); keep an eye out for tax-related mail (W-2s, 1099s); consider your filing options; and visit www.irs.gov for help.
